(with in 1 or 2) or in worse case please share players with them. Throw-ins conform to std. USSF rules.		
Penalty kicks taken per std. USSF rules.	Fouls: After a hand ball, pushing, tripping or other penal foul, a direct free kick is awarded to the team suffering from the infraction at the point of the foul. An indirect free kick (goal not scored directly on kick) is awarded for non-penal fouls. When a call is made please explain to the player the call and why it was made.	Game length: Two 25-minute halves - but please trim period length accordingly if you start late so you can end on time
Goal kicks taken from line of goal box. Opponents should be 8 yards from the ball until it's in play.		
Corner Kicks conform to USSF rules Opponents should be 8 yards from the ball until it's in play.		
Offsides is called per USSF rules. All players play a minimum of 50% of the game. Each player plays at least half of the game.		Breaks: one 5-minute halftime break
Substitutions can be taken at any stoppage of play when your team controls the ball. Please call out your intent to sub		
Coaches are not to be on the field during the games. The referees manage t he games. Treat them with respect.
